

DROPS ON A PENNY

OBJECTIVE:

Students will test different liquids to see how many drops will fit on the surface of a penny.

MATERIALS:

- Penny
- Cookie sheet
- 5 droppers with liquids



PROCEDURES:

1. Place a penny on the cookie sheet.
2. Using one of the droppers, count how many drops of vinegar you can drop on the penny's surface until it spills over.
3. Record your data on the student data sheet.
4. Clean and dry penny.

****REPEAT THIS PROCESS FOR ALL 5 LIQUIDS.**

CLEAN UP:

Clean and dry cookie sheet, penny and pipets.
