- 1. Carefully unwrap your "Perfect Pellet"™ an a clean working surface
- 2. Inspect your pellet, note: size and bones. You are a scientist.
- 3. Very gently, pull apart your pellet, being very careful not to break any bones.
- 4. Carefully separate the bones from the fur or feathers. Teasing needles or toothpicks work well. Take special care removing skulls and jaws because they are the best way to identify the animal.
- Roll the last bits of fur between your fingers to find little bones or teeth that may have been overlooked.
- 6. Try to lay out or reconstruct the skeletons of the animals you have found. Identify the animals.
