Project Requirements:

Volcano Information

- 1. Location: where is your volcano situated (located)?
 - a. (Be sure to include the proximity of your volcano to plate boundaries and anything else unique or significant about its location.
- 2. Name of other volcanoes that are near, their names, and how they are arranged, i.e. clusters, chains, etc.)
- 3. **Eruption Activity**: is the volcano active or dormant? Explain.
- 4. When was the last significant eruption?
- 5. How many significant eruptions has it had?
- 6. Were scientists able to detect any warning signs of the last (or any) eruption? If so, what were they?
- 7. **Type**: what type of volcano is this?
- 8. **Describe the eruptions** that you would expect from this volcano. How does this volcano type relate to other volcano types?
- 9. **Impact**: how has this volcano affected humans in the surrounding area (economy, agriculture, structures, air quality, etc.)
- 10. Pictures: you should include at least three pictures or diagrams of your volcano (or related to your volcano).
- 11. Be sure to include citations for your sources of information, including pictures and diagrams.
